This EMBO Conference brought together leading experts on ubiquitin and ubiquitin-like proteins and the cells processes regulated by these post-translational modifications to discuss new findings of the field. In parallel with the EMBO Conference, PROTEOSTASIS organized the annual MC and WG Meeting which gathered together the members of the network (more than 200 research groups in 27 EU countries) and consolidated the work carried out in terms of scientific collaborations, exchanges of students and mobility. Besides, it was a unique opportunity to set the basis for future directions and define the terms of the "proof of concept" in the translational projects of this COST Action.


